Encourage improvements to the garage forecourt and boundaries, the car park next to the Coronation Club, and site adjoining no. 121 Rowland Road.

Amend the conservation area boundary to exclude Queen Street, nos 138 and 140 Rowland Road, and the Frodingham Community Centre.

Re-affirm the Article 4 Direction which controls alterations to the front elevation of the most of the unlisted houses in the conservation area and take enforcement action where works have been implemented without planning permission.
