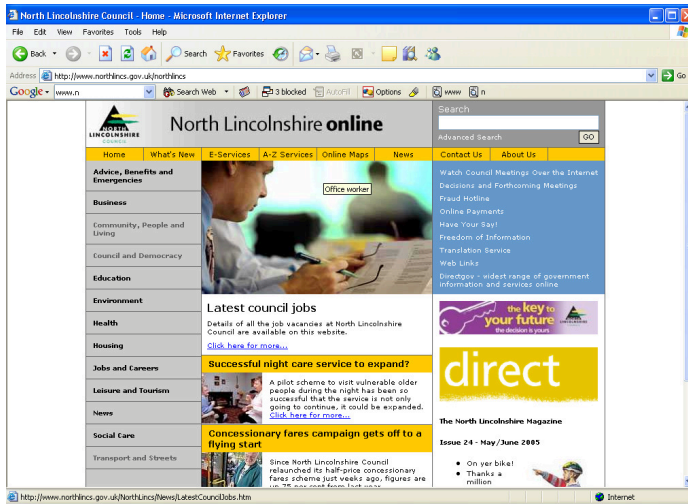

I hope more people will contact the council with their concerns."

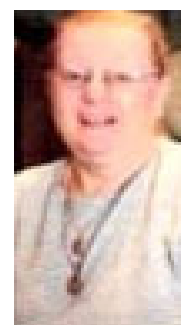
