What is The Local Safeguarding Children's Board? (LSCB)

The Government passed a piece of Law called The Children Act 2004 that says that the Local Council and other people like the Police (Telephone number 0845 6060 222) and NHS and Schools have to work better together to keep children safe.

It says that one of the ways they need to do this is by having the people who make the decisions in those agencies come together regularly on a Board called The Local Safeguarding Children's Board.

North Lincolnshire has a Local Safeguarding Children's Board and it is made up of the decision makers from The Local Authority, The Health Service, The Police, Connexions, Children and Family Court Advisory Support Services (CAFCASS), The Probation Service, Schools and Colleges. This Board meets every two months.

What will it do?

The LSCB has a responsibility to help Children and Young People to be safe and not harmed.

It has a responsibility to monitor how well people who work with children, young people and families are doing to try and help children to stay safe.

It also has to ensure that staff who work with children and families are all working to the same rules or procedures and have training to help them to their jobs as well as they can.

The LSCB has to write a plan that sets out what they are going to do to try and help children stay safe and how they are going to do it, this is called a Strategic Plan.
