Don't let them get away with it!

North Lincolnshire Council believes that everyone - its staff, service users and council tax payers - has an interest in ensuring that council money and property is protected from those who seek to steal and misuse it.

With a budget of over £200m, we are committed to making sure that all council money is used for the purposes it was intended.

That's why the council has introduced a policy which enables anyone to report instances of fraud, theft or corruption without fear of discrimination. A special hotline with trained staff is open between 9.30am and 12 noon, and 2pm and 4pm on weekdays; outside these hours, you can leave a recorded message. You do not have to give your name.

If you see or hear of anyone who is:

- getting money from the council that they are not entitled to - this could be payments for contracts, supplies, grants, benefits or salaries;
- stealing or misusing council stores, equipment, vehicles or buildings.

We will look into all reported incidents thoroughly and take appropriate action.
