Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 36, Barton) Order 2005(1)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) – namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a highway shown or required to be shown in the map or statement has been authorised to be stopped up, diverted, widened or extended – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 3rd May 2005.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 36, Barton) Order 2005(1).

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Description of path to be deleted

A – B as indicated on the map: A 308-metre-long footpath commencing at the south-western corner of O.S. Field No. 8763 at grid reference TA0181122531, proceeding in an easterly direction across Field No. 7446 to Gravel Pit Road to grid reference TA0150822542.

Description of path to be added

A – C as indicated on the map: A 198-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.5 metres commencing at the south-western corner of O.S. Field No. 8763, known as Allotment Gardens, at grid reference TA0181122531, proceeding along the eastern boundary of O.S. Field No. 7446 and the western side of a hedgerow in a northerly direction to grid reference TA0183522727.

C – D as indicated on the map: A 62-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.5 metres commencing at the north-eastern corner of O.S. Field No. 7446 at grid reference TA018352727, proceeding along the northern boundary of the same field and the southern side of a drainage dyke in a westerly direction before crossing a 7.5 metre footbridge to an adopted highway known as Dam Road at grid reference TA0177822738.

PART 2

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Variation of particulars of path

A 260-metre-long footpath commencing at the south-western corner of O.S. Field No. 8763, known as Allotment Gardens, at grid reference TA0181122531, proceeding along the eastern boundary of O.S. Field No. 7446 and the western side of a hedgerow in a northerly direction to grid reference TA0183522727, and then along the northern boundary of the same field and the southern side of a drainage dyke in a westerly direction before crossing a 7.5 metre footbridge to an adopted highway known as Dam Road at grid reference TA0177822738. The footpath has a minimum width of 1.5 metres throughout.

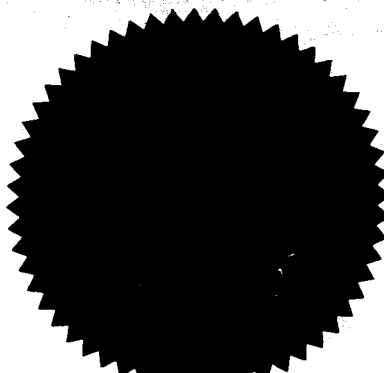

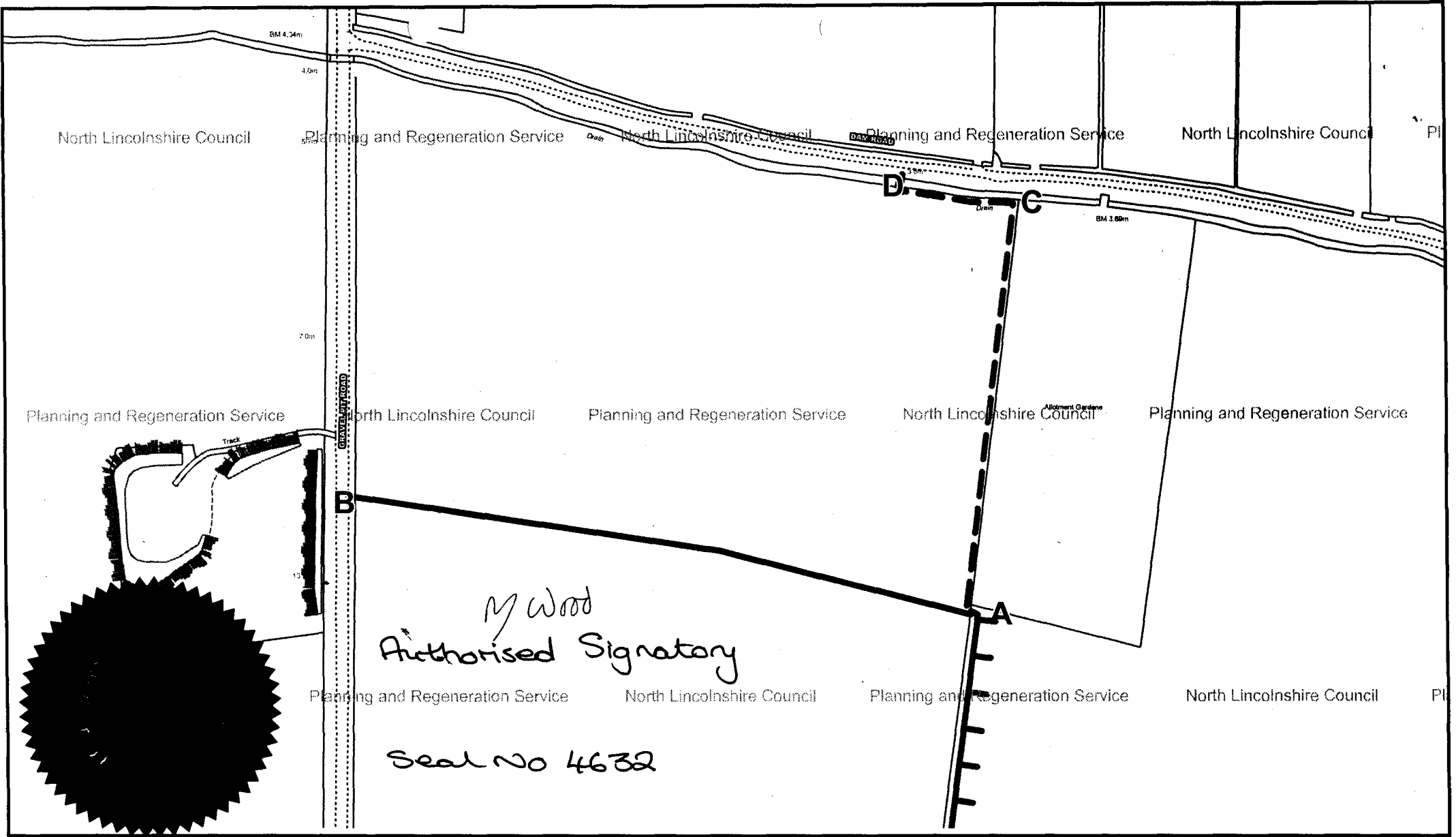
