- Bath time is a great opportunity to offer a range of containers to pour and fill. Listen to the range of sounds the water makes as it flows out from different heights and nozzles. Use words such as ;
SPLISH; SPLOSH; SPLASH
Drip, Drop
Plip, Plop
Faster, slower
Heavy rain, gentle rain....
Give time for your child to think of words too.
- On a rainy day, wrap up warm and go for a walk using an umbrella. Listen to the natural sounds. Explore the puddles together. Can you see your reflection?
- Pretend a doll or teddy has bumped it's head. Explore how to care for someone who is poorly. Cuddles, bandages, drinks, a warm blanket....
