Fun things to do!

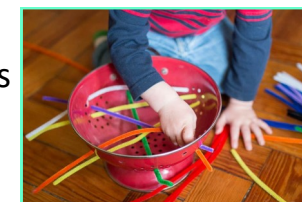


Sing slowly with your child and show them the actions as described in the rhyme. Repeat again and again and pause to allow time for your child to join in with the words or actions.
