- ◆ Play in the bath, sink or paddling pool, pouring drinks and have a pretend tea party. This is great for hand and eye coordination; knowing when to stop and start pouring so that the cup doesn't overflow.
- ◆ Pretend you're in a café. Who will you make a drink for? What will they choose? Hot chocolate, orange juice, water ... Take turns to be the customer or the waiter/ waitress.
- ◆ A great chance to use and understand lots of mathematical language; full, empty, half a cup, heavy, light, more, less, practise filling and measuring accurately. Guess how many tea cups the kettle can fill? This helps with estimating and counting.
