Fun Family Rhyme Challenge Quiz

Information for Early Years Provider and Schools

Why not get your families to take part in this rhyme challenge quiz, helping to raise funds for your school/setting and the North Lincolnshire Children's Literacy Trust.

The quiz will contain a selection of rhyme related questions – some your child can answer, others you may need to involve the entire family (including grandmas and grandads)

How it works.

- Print off and sell copies of the quiz to your families (See page 2)
- You can sell these for £1 or £2 per sheet, based on what you think is an acceptable charge to your families.
- 50% of money raised goes to your school/setting and 50% of money raised goes to the North Lincolnshire Children's Literacy Trust. Alternatively simply make a donation to the trust.
- You could either; hold a family quiz afternoon/evening during July and the family with the most correct answers win's a small prize, or alternatively you could let families purchase the sheet and take it home, give them a week to complete the sheet. All returned correct sheets get put into a hat and a winner is drawn at random to win a small prize.
