Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 7, Burton Stather) Order 2005(1)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) – namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a highway shown or required to be shown in the map or statement has been authorised to be stopped up, diverted, widened or extended – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 3rd May 2005.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 7, Burton Stather) Order 2005(1).

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Description of path to be deleted

A – B as indicated on the map: A 105-metre-long footpath commencing on Stather Road at grid reference SE8693017861, proceeding over O.S. Field number 9392 in a northerly direction to its junction on the existing footpath at grid reference SE8695917951.

Description of path to be added

C – D as indicated on the map: A 51-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.25 metres commencing on Stather Road at grid reference SE8699217832, proceeding first up stone steps on the western side of St Andrew's Church wall and the eastern side of an enclosure fence in a northerly direction to the south side of a boundary of a property known as Hillside Cottage at grid reference SE8698817885.

D – E as indicated on the map: A 21-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.25 metres commencing on the south side of a boundary to a property known as Hillside Cottage and the north side of an enclosure fence at grid reference SE8698817885, proceeding in a westerly direction to the east side of a boundary to a property known as Hillcross at grid reference SE8696817885.

E – F as indicated on the map: A 18-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.25 metres commencing on the east side of a boundary to a property known as Hillcross and the west side of a boundary to a property known as Hillside Cottage at grid reference SE8696817885, proceeding in a first northerly, then north-westerly direction to the west side of the north-western boundary point of Hillside Cottage at grid reference SE8696417901.

F – B as indicated on the map: A 52-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.25 metres commencing on the west side of the north-western boundary point of a property known as Hillside Cottage and the west side of railings enclosing St Andrew's Church and the east side of a hedge belonging to a property known as Hillcross at grid reference SE8696417901, proceeding in a northerly direction to the west side of the north-western corner of St Andrew's Church boundary and the east side of the north-eastern boundary of a property known as Woodlands to a point on the existing footpath at grid reference SE8695917951.

PART 2

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Statement

Variation of particulars of path

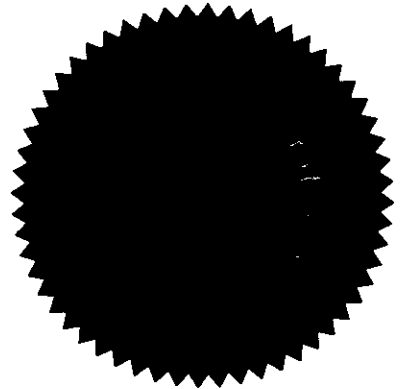
A 142-metre-long footpath commencing on Stather Road at grid reference SE8699217832, proceeding first up stone steps on the western side of St Andrew's Church wall and the eastern side of an enclosure fence in a northerly direction to grid reference SE8698817885, and then along the southern side of a boundary to a property known as Hillside Cottage and the northern side of an enclosure fence in a westerly direction to grid reference SE8696817885, and then along the western side of a boundary fence of the same property and the eastern side of a hedge belonging to a property known as Hillcross in a first northerly, then north-westerly direction to grid reference SE8696417901, and then along the western side of railings enclosing St Andrew's Church and first the eastern side of a hedge belonging to a property known as Hillcross, and then the eastern side of a fence belonging to a property known as Woodlands in a northerly direction to the west side of the north-western corner of St Andrew's Church boundary and the east side of the north-eastern boundary of the property known as Woodlands to a point on the existing footpath at grid reference SE8695917951. The footpath has a width of 1.25 metres throughout.

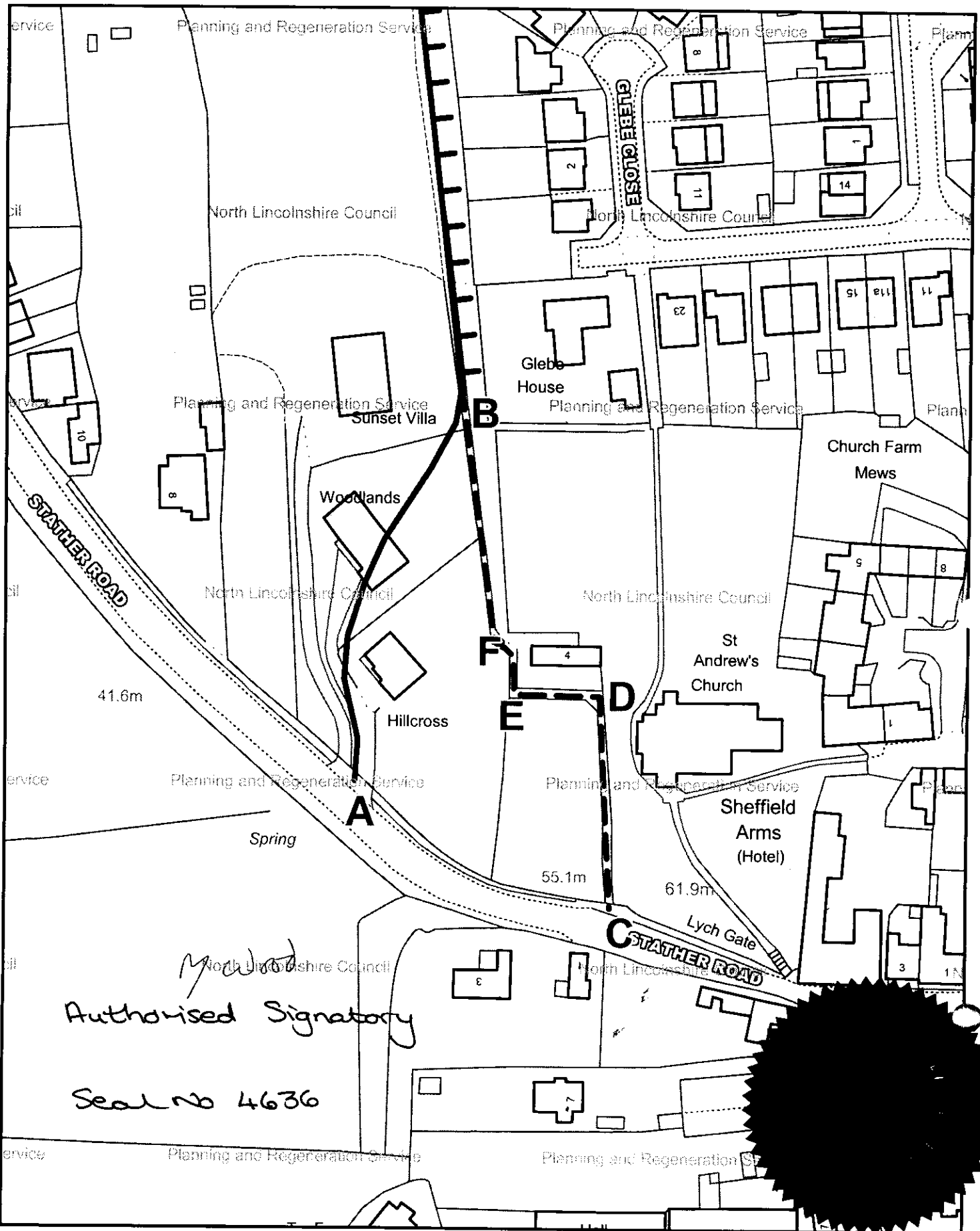
