

PUBLIC FOOTPATH 171 BURTON UPON STATHER 2011(1)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (the 1981 Act) because it appears to the authority that the "County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg)" definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Burton upon Stather and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 56 days from the date of confirmation of this order and thereupon the "County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg)" definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. There shall at the end of 42 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Burton upon Stather described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this order and thereupon the "County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg)" definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
- 2A.The "County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg)" definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing path

Point A—B as indicated on the map: a 155-metre-long footpath commencing at grid reference SE86771741 and leading northwards to grid reference SE86921760.

PART 2

Description of site of new path

Point A—C as indicated on the map: a 223-metre-long footpath with a width of two metres, commencing at grid reference SE86771741 (Point A) and leading northwards to point C at grid reference SE86781763.

PART 3

Modification of Definitive Statement

Variation of Particulars of Path or Way

A 223-metre-long footpath with a width of 2 metres commencing from a point on the public highway, known as Wood Hill at grid reference SE86771741 and proceeding north to its junction with the existing Public Footpath 170 at grid reference SE86781763.
