

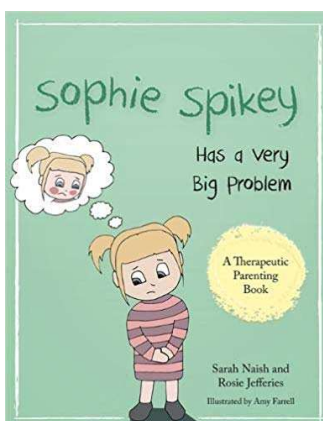
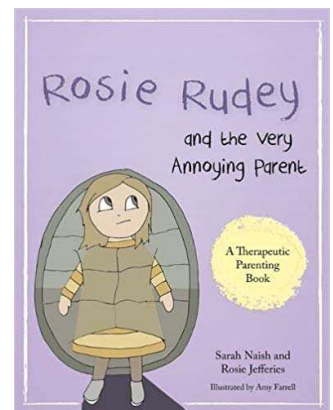
William Wobbly and the very bad day : a story about when feelings become too big / Sarah Naish, Rosie Jefferies / illustrated by Amy Farrell

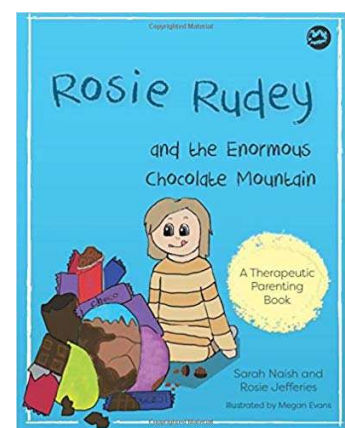

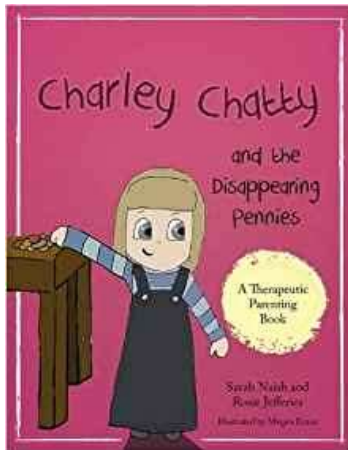

Charley chatty and the disappearing pennies : a story about lying and stealing / Sarah Naish, Rosie Jefferies / illustrated by Megan Evans

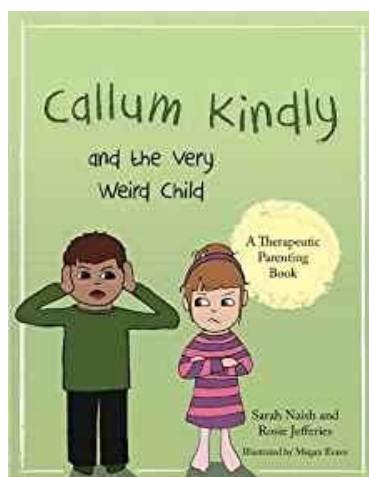
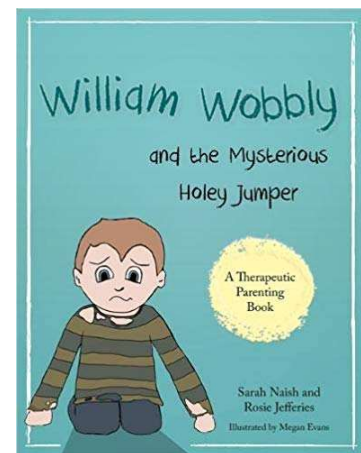
