



### Looking for numbers

This game helps your child learn about numbers while you are out and about. You can make it a fun game that keeps them entertained.

Encourage your child to spot the number that is the same as their age. Make sure they know what it is and what the number looks like. Ask them where they can see that number, for example on doors, cars or signs.



### Good to know

It is important to help children to see that numbers are everywhere. Recognising numbers will help them with maths as they get older.
