

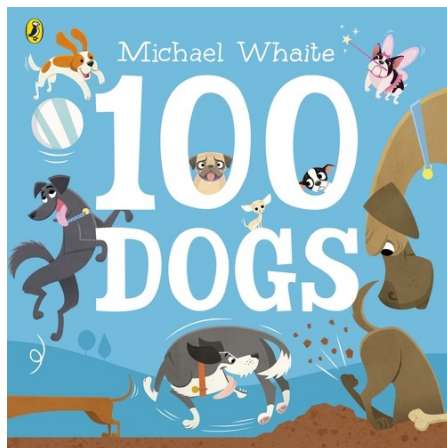

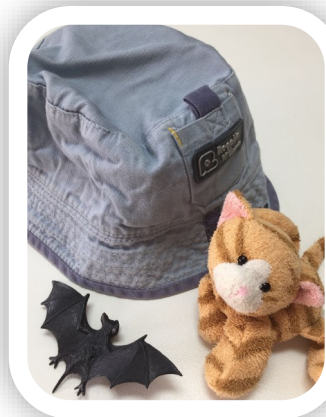


Small dog, tall dog, playing with a ball

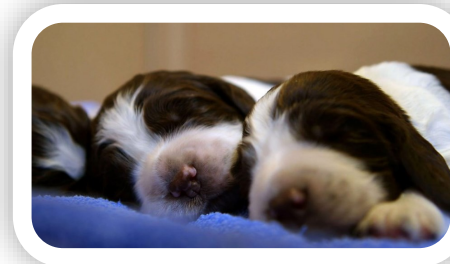
Rhyme Zone

You can play this rhyming game anywhere,
anytime. Think of a fun word, then let your
child think of another word that rhymes
with it. Take turns and keep going back and
forth as long as you can! Hat? Bat? Cat?
Rhyming games, like this one, help your
child focus on word sounds. This will help
with reading and writing later on.

Pet story time. Your child can read a story
to their dog, pet or a toy. This will give
your child the confidence to share a story
in their own words. Sharing stories this
way will help them to recall the story or
