

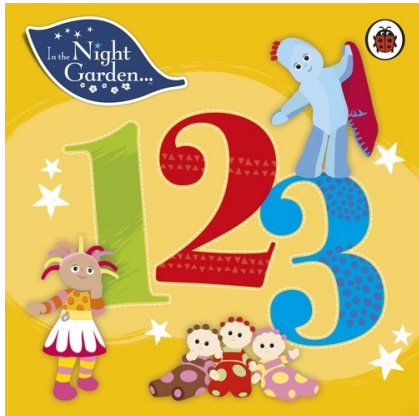

A big fat hen;

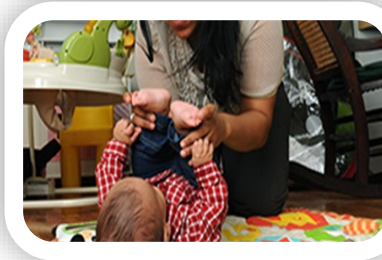
