

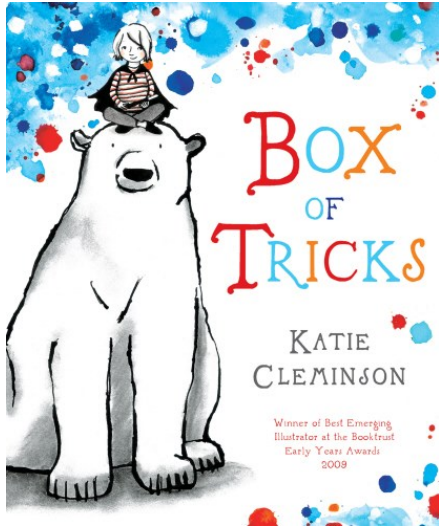

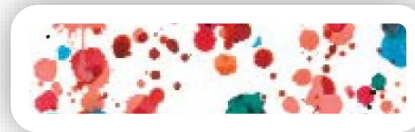
Box of Tricks Fun things to do!
