I, Caroline Lacey, as the Police Area Returning Officer appointed at the Election for the Police and Crime Commissioner for the Humberside Police Area on 6 May 2021, hereby certify that:

The total number of valid first preference votes cast for each of the candidates across the Humber area is as follows:

Name of Candidate	Description	Number of Votes	% of Votes
EVISON, Jonathan	The Conservative Party Candidate	71,554	45.6%
HUNTER, Keith	Labour and Co-operative Party	61,859	39.4%
MORGAN, Robert Victor (commonly known as Bob)	Liberal Democrats	23,640	15.1%

The total number of ballot papers verified is 160,734

The turnout in this police area at this election is 22.92%

The total number of rejected ballot papers is 3,598

As no candidate received more than 50% of the valid first preference votes the top two candidates will go forward to the next stage. The second preference votes for the eliminated candidates will now be counted. The remaining candidates are:

HUNTER, Keith	Labour and Co-operative Party
