

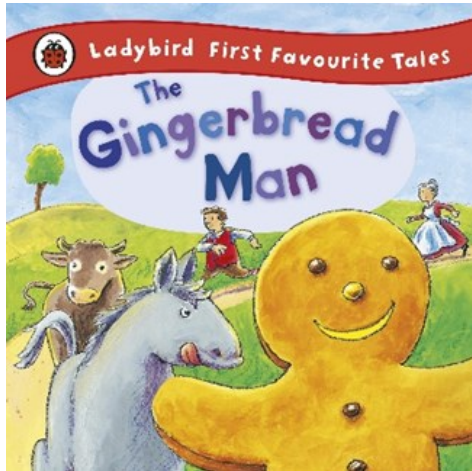

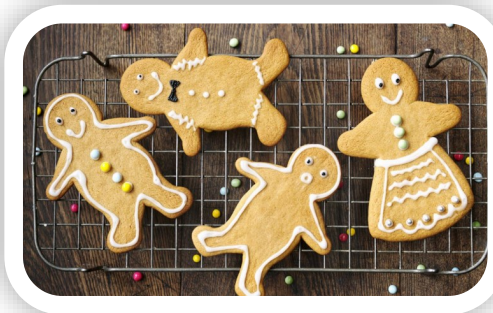

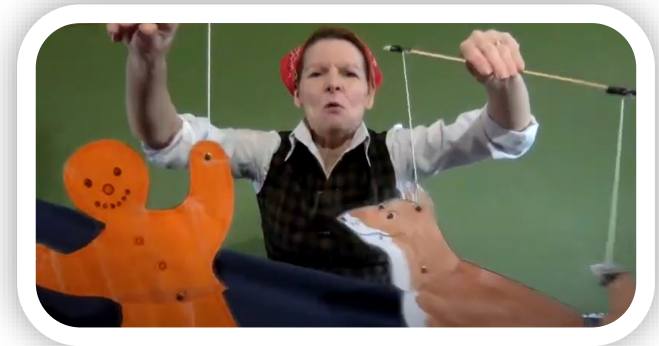


The Gingerbread Man Fun things to do!
