You will need red, green, blue and yellow to colour in the Lincolnshire Flag below.


Look at the numbers on the flag to see which colour you need to use.





Lincolnshire Day

We celebrate Lincolnshire Day on 1st October every year.

The date was chosen because it is the anniversary of the Lincolnshire Uprising.

In 1536, people in Lincolnshire were unhappy that King Henry VIII had formed a new church, The Church of England, and they rebelled against him.



The Lincolnshire Flag

The Lincolnshire flag has a red cross, the Saint George's Cross, representing England.

Yellow represents the crops grown in the county, and the nickname "Yellowbellies".

Blue represents the sea on the coast and the wide skies of Lincolnshire.

Green symbolises the county's lush fields.

The Fleur de Lys symbol in the middle is a recognised symbol of the City of Lincoln.



Lincolnshire 'Yellowbellies'

'Yellowbelly' is a nickname for people from Lincolnshire.

No-one is sure where the nickname came from, but it could be from the old Lincolnshire Regiment in the army who had yellow-fronted uniforms, or a type of newt found in Lincolnshire that has a yellow underside.
