# 8. Any Other Business

AB informed the panel that Amcotts has been nominated for a National RHS Spring in Bloom small village award. The village has been recognised as being in the top 6 in the country and will be judged with the other 5 small villages from Ulster, Lancashire, Norfolk, Cumbria and Durham. This project has previously been funded by SSE. A representative from the village will attend an awards ceremony in London in October.

The group received notification of their nomination on 9<sup>th</sup> February after the closing date for the SSE applications. AB informed the panel that the group would like them to consider an application via written procedures to prepare the village for national judging.
