Notice is hereby given that North Lincolnshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 81 (1), 82(2)(a), 83(2), 84(1) and (2), 84(3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to amend the Order specified in the Schedule to the extent described in that Schedule. A copy of the draft Order showing the amendments together with a statement of reasons and plan showing the sides and lengths of road affected are on display at the Barton Local Link Office. Objections to the proposal specifying the grounds on which they are made should be sent in writing to the Traffic Safety Team, Billet Lane, Normanby Enterprise Park, Scunthorpe DN15 9YH not later than 20th Oct 2022.

SCHEDULE

To amend the North Lincolnshire Borough Council (Various Roads) (Restricted/De-restricted Roads and Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2013 as follows and as shown on drawing YHN5006/20BART/01:

20mph Speed Limit

To impose a 20mph Speed Limit on the following Streets/Roads - Fleetgate, Newport, Overton Court, Maltby Lane, Finkle Lane, Hungate, Junction Square, Chapel Lane, Vestry Lane, George St, Cottage Lane, Priestgate, St Mary's Lane, Burgate, King St, Soutergate, High St, Queen St, Longs Garden, Catherine St, Marsh Lane (Butts Rd to High St Section), Bramley Close, St Peter's Orchard, Queen's Ave, Tangarth Court
