

## Notice of Making of an Order

### Public Path Creation and Definitive Map Modification (Public Bridleway 119, Epworth and Haxey) Order 2022(1)

The above order, made on 2 March 2022, will create a public bridleway of a length of 1,410 metres and a width of three metres running generally southwards from Studcross, Epworth, to Carr Lane, Low Burnham, via part of Public Footpath 67, then part of a north-south-track continuation, then part of an east-west track and then part of the former light railway, and the definitive map will be modified in consequence.

A copy of the order and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Church Square House, 30-40 High Street, Scunthorpe, DN15 6NL from 9am to 4.30pm on weekdays. Copies of the order and map may be bought there at the price of £1.50. You must state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Lincolnshire Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
