#### Item Notes

#### 1. Notes of Last Meeting and Matters Arising

Notes of the meeting held 7June 2022 were agreed as a true record.

(SSE 275) Crowle & Ealand Regeneration Project Ltd – funding to replace the front entrance doors to the building.

CJR Declared an interest

Following a planning review, it has been decided to keep the existing door and install a roller shutter security shield in front of it thus maintaining security and accessibility. This can be done well within the original agreed costs of £1,700.

The group requested that the panel consider a project alteration. The panel agreed to support this.

JD mentioned that the following recommendations from the SSE Audit are to be included on the AGM agenda: fraud awareness and the need to declare conflicts of interest.

JD informed the panel that representatives from Amcotts attended the RHS Regional Finals in Loughborough on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> September to represent Amcotts. They collected: Judges Award for the Children's Display and Butterfly Garden at Church Silver for Best Public House Garden

Gold for Best Small Village in the East Midlands Region

#### 2. Projects Update

Completed projects:

(SSE 238) Scunthorpe Junior Choir – project involved creating a North Axholme school choir by running children's workshops and supporting teachers. Completed in July 2022.

(SSE 273) St Mark's Community Group – The group have advised that due to ongoing issues they have decided not to undertake the electrical and plumbing elements. The vestry roof has been completed and funding claimed for that work, which completes this project. The group intend to reapply for funding in the future and therefore outstanding monies will be returned to the fund.

#### Outstanding projects:

(SSE 279) Crowle & Ealand Playing Field Association – funding to refurbish the community room and install energy efficient lighting. The installation of new LED lighting is almost complete after which plumbing and decoration work will commence.

(SSE 278) Crowle Bowls Club – the new clubhouse project has started with the demolition phase of the project due to be completed by the end of September 2022. The project is due to be completed in March or April 2023.

(SSE 282) Garthorpe and Fockerby Parish Council – the parish council have sought additional funding due to the reduced funding offer from SSE. They have applied to North Lincolnshire Council Community Grant Fund which is awaiting approval.

#### **Shared Winter Warmth Allocation**

JD distributed an appraisal for a proposed Shared Winter Warmth Fund Allocation. SSE have given their support for the proposal.

Discussion took place and the panel agreed to fund two elements to ease the rise in energy costs:

- £12,000 to support continuation of the existing provision within premises across North Axholme and Gunness & Burringham. This will allow premises to remain open and available without the need to increase rental costs for groups using the premises whilst offering warm and safe spaces for communities. Maximum grant available of £750.
- £10,000 to support the provision of new activities for winter 2022/23 with an aim to provide additional opportunities for community activities within warm and safe spaces in local communities across North Axholme and Gunness & Burringham. Maximum grant of £750

The decision for both elements will be agreed by a sub-panel. The Grants Team to develop the grant conditions and guidance.
