

THE NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL
(Various Roads) (Restricted/De-Restricted Roads and Speed
Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2013 (Barton-upon-Humber
Town Centre) (20mph Speed Limit) (Amendment No 15) Order 2023

Notice is hereby given that on 25th Jan 2023, North Lincolnshire Council made an Order under Sections 81 (1), 82(2)(a), 83(2), 84(1) and (2), 84(3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to amend the Order specified in the Schedule to the extent described in that Schedule. This Order will take effect on 1st Feb 2023. A copy of the Order showing the amendments together with a statement of reasons and plan showing the sides and lengths of road affected are on display at the Barton Local Link Office. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that a requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with you may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for that purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE

To amend the North Lincolnshire Borough Council (Various Roads) (Restricted/De-restricted Roads and Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2013 as follows and as shown on drawing YHN5006/20BART/01:

20mph Speed Limit

To impose a 20mph Speed Limit on the following Streets/Rds in Barton-upon-Humber - Fleetgate, Newport, Overton Court, Maltby Lane, Finkle Lane, Hungate, Junction Square, Chapel Lane, Vestry Lane, George St, Cottage Lane, Priestgate, St Mary's Lane, Burgate, King St, Soutergate, High St, Queen St, Longs Garden, Catherine St, Marsh Lane (Butts Rd to High St Section), Bramley Close, St Peter's Orchard, Queen's Ave, Tangarth Court
