	(SDF 068) – Warley Road – Outdoor Gym Community notice board has now been installed. Tenders for the main works were sent
	out in December 2022 but due to rising costs no one has tendered a quote as cannot
	supply within the budget set. A meeting with NLC and Local Councillor has taken place to discuss plans for going forward. A meeting with the grants team regarding going forward will be requested.
	(SDF 076) – Scunthorpe Bowls – Erect new Bowls Pavilion

The group have completed all of the requirements that North Lincolnshire Council Building Control have asked them to do and received permission on 31 January 2023 to commence work on the New build.

(SDF 078) - Hibaldstow Village Hall - Installation of Solar Panels

Solar panels have been installed and are operating. Electrical work now completed changing all heating away from gas, all lights now low energy and replacement of emergency exit signage and lights to current standard. Showers in changing areas now electric and electric water heating solution in place in toilets and kitchen.
