1.	Apologies & Welcome MB sent apologies. CJB sent apologies but supports all applications. CW sent apologies but supports all applications except SSE 302 in which she declared
	an interest.
2.	SSE Update JF provided the following updates.
	 Keadby 2 – The plant has now been handed over to the SSE operations team who will lead on the day to day running of the site. Points of contact remain unchanged and any questions relating to operations can be directed to Jade Fernandez. Keadby 3 Carbon Capture SSE Thermal are still awaiting the outcome of the Government's Cluster Sequencing process, meaning that no Final Investment Decision has been made for the project. The project team are working towards the commencement of the Development Consent Order (DCO) – there are several conditions (known as 'requirements') that need to be discharged in advance, such as the Skills and Employment Plan – which SSE are currently working on in collaboration with North Lincolnshire Council. In advance of the full works commencing there are several activities that SSE are permitted to undertake, things such as surveys, vegetation clearance in advance of the upgrade works for Mabey Bridge (the main access bridge over the A18) and the internal site road. It is essential that SSE begin those activities as soon as possible to enable the upgrades this year and meet the current

programme. These upgrades are desirable whether or not Keadby 3 proceeds due to the condition of Mabey Bridge and will ensure the A18 access remains useable by the range of site traffic. The above activities could commence in the coming weeks, potentially before the end of April so JF wanted to share with members so they are aware. SSE are still working to finalise the contract for these activities. JF has fed in to the project team in terms of ensuring there is the correct signage and routes to site to avoid any mistakes relating to vehicles entering the village. The site entrance now has a dedicated postcode which should avoid issues. 3. Notes of Last Meeting and Matters Arising Notes of the meeting held 13 December 2022, agreed as a true record. Written procedure for Luddington Village Hall Refurbishment (SSE 287) for £10,460 was agreed in full by written procedure on condition that any existing unwanted tables and chairs are offered to and utilised by local community groups. Micro Grant Fund – the panel had requested an update, JD confirmed to be included on agenda for the next meeting to provide an update based on the reported spend from the Parish Councils for the current financial year. JD reminded that panel that all Micro grant claims need to be received by Parish Clerks before the end of the financial year so the funds can be replenished. **Project Update** 4. (SSE 282) Garthorpe & Fockerby Parish Council – funding for Lawnmower. Awaiting delivery of the mower. PW advised it is due to arrive on Thursday 9 March. (SSE 283) Gunness Parish Council – funding for Speed signage. The group have ordered and paid for the supply and installation of the posts from North Lincolnshire Council along with two speed devices from Truvelo. They are awaiting the outcome of a decision about the location of these devices from North Lincolnshire Council. CJR advised that the location of speed signage be identified prior to being put forward for a decision in respect of future applications of this nature. (SSE 286) Keadby with Althorpe Parish Council – funding for Outdoor Gym Equipment in Keadby. The equipment has been installed and the project is now complete. VT commented that she had used the equipment. 5. **Finance Update** The funds available for allocation for the Main fund are: £110,048. Applications for consideration for funding from the Main fund: £46,164 (including £2,329 for SSE 293 which was sent to the panel separately). The funds available for allocation for the Gunness & Burringham fund are: £5,326. Applications for consideration for funding from Gunness & Burringham: £0.
