3.	Projects Update
	(SDF 068) – Warley Road – Outdoor Gym Project has been completed and the group are awaiting an invoice from North Lincolnshire Council so they can claim the grant award.
	(SDF 086) – Crowle Community Hall – Solar Panels Solar Panels are now installed. Group will evaluate the financial benefits going forward. The project will enable the community hall to continue to maintain low hire rates for users. Project complete.
	(SDF 088) – Garthorpe Village Hall – Solar Panels and LED lighting Solar Panels are now installed – too early to say what the financial benefit will be but to be monitored moving forward. Project complete.
	(SDF 087) – The Forge Project – Solar Panels The group have paid a 25% deposit and the project is due to start.
	(SDF 080) – Scunthorpe Sea Cadets – Environmentally Friendly site Progress has been made towards the renovation of the site and they will soon be ready to order and start replanting trees – they have been advised to do so in March 2024 towards the back end of the project. Moving forward, they plan to continue with the site clearance and make safe the areas for cadets, visitors, and volunteers. The Grants Team to organise a date for the panel to visit the site.
