Plastic Bottle Planter



Plastic bottles can make fantastic hanging planters for a kitchen window or garden. By recycling plastic bottles and growing plants it helps the environment and is fun to do.

What you need:

Plastic bottle • Scissors • Pen • String • Soil

Instructions :

- Remove the cap and label from the plastic bottle and draw a large circle half way down. This will become the opening for your planter.
- 2. Ask an adult to help you to cut out the circle on the side of your plastic bottle and make a small hole on either side of the top of the bottle.
- **3.** Feed the string through the holes and tie the ends together.
- **4.** Put some soil into the hole and plant a seed/plant of your choice in your bottle.
- **5.** If you're planning on hanging your planter outdoors, make a few holes in the bottom of the bottle to allow for drainage.
- **6.** Your planter is now reading for hanging, water your plant regularly.
