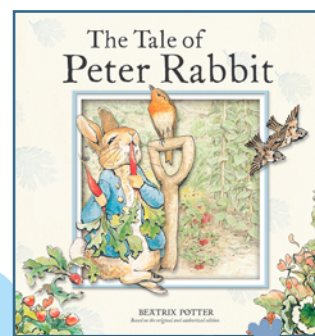

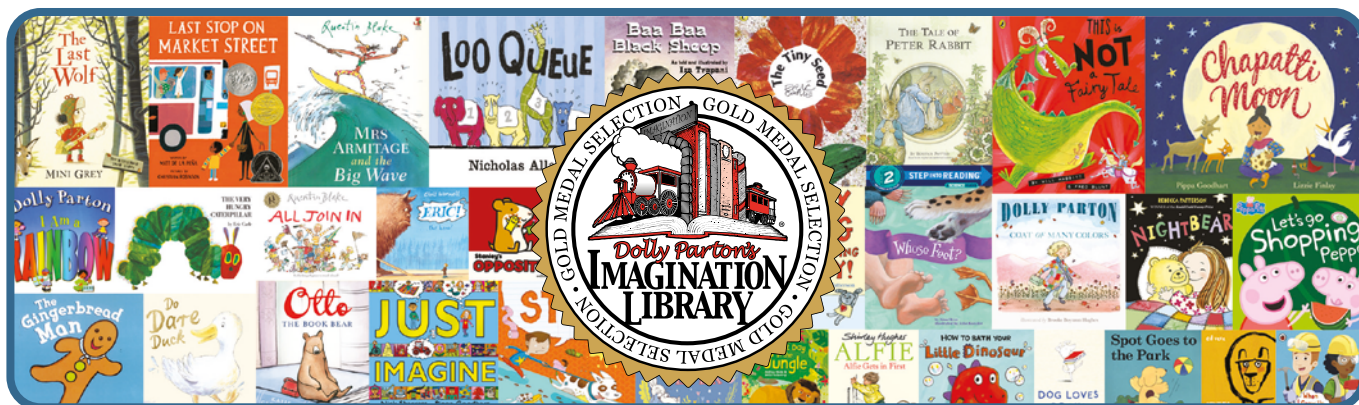


## THE TALE OF PETER RABBIT
