












PEEKABOO! - FARM

It's playtime on the farm! Enjoy a game of hide-and-seek with all the barnyard animals waiting to pop up and surprise you.

Read the lively rhymes out loud with your little one for an interactive story time. Learn the names of the farm animals and how to count from 1 to 5.



Collect some toy farm animals. Hide them one at a time in a box or bag. Make the noise of each animal and encourage your little one to copy you as they try to guess what it might be. Name each animal as you slowly reveal them.





Exploring Texture

As you are reading the book talk about how the different animals might feel; "fluffy sheep", "prickly hedgehog", "smooth cow" or "feathery duck".

For a fun activity for your little one to help with their language development; glue different squares of material together or onto a piece of cardboard. Describe how they feel; "fluffy", "rough", "smooth", etc.
