Eligibility Criteria for Mopeds

- You must be 16 years or over
- If under 18, a parent or guardian must act as guarantor
- You must live within the county of North Lincolnshire
- You must have a driving licence with 'AM' category on and with current address
- You will need proof of a firm offer of work, training, apprenticeship, or college placement, for 16 hours a week or more. For a period of not less than two months. This will be checked
- Or be already in work, training, apprenticeship, or college for 16 hours or more
- At risk of losing job or placement due to transport difficulties. You will be asked about this
- Distance from home to work three miles or more to qualify for scheme. Distance and type of journey can affect which scooter you are offered. We will do our best to meet your needs
- The length and difficulty of commute could affect the decision, avoid motorways
- You must check public transport availability for your shift/work/training start time, finish time and include weekends if applicable
- We need to know how you are commuting currently
- You must be able to secure a scooter at home in a locked garden, shed or garage away from the public highway - this will be checked before decision taken
- If all the above are ok and you are accepted onto the scheme, you will need to take a training course before the handover. It is called Compulsory Basic Training or CBT course. The helmet and gloves are collected from the trainer. Once you are accepted details will be sent to you.
- You need to make sure you can afford the deposit and monthly payments; a
 deposit and first month's hire will need to be paid before the handover. Details
 will be sent to you
- The handover always takes place at our Depot and takes about an hour. Details
 will be sent to you with time and what to bring. The security chain and Hi-Viz
 waistcoat will be collected at this point.
