Your child, and anyone else joining in, must follow the leader and do the action they call out, but only when Teddy says.

If the leader says, "Teddy says touch your nose", everyone must touch their nose. However, if the leader just says, "Touch your nose", no one should do this.

Have fun together making up different actions and don't worry if your child makes some mistakes. This game is great for listening and concentration skills.

Building an animal home.
