	(SDF 068) – Warley Road Community Group – Outdoor fitness equipment at Healey Road Community Park The project has attracted increased users and visitors to the park, creating a positive impact on social, health and well-being within the community. Project complete.	
	(SDF 084) – Broughton Village Hall – Solar Panels with battery storage The solar panels have been installed. Too early to know what the financial savings may be, it is anticipated the group will benefit from lower energy bills. Project complete.	
	(SDF 087) – The Forge Project – Solar Panels The project was delayed pending authorisation from the Methodist Council in Manchester (who own the building). This was approved and the project was completed on 12 th January 2024.	
	(SDF 080) – Scunthorpe Sea Cadets – Environmentally Friendly site Progress has been made towards the renovation of the site which will create a large green space, allowing them to start replanting trees in March 2024. The group plan to hold a family day on the site for residents of Keadby and surrounding area in the new year once the project is complete. The Grants team to advise the panel of the date.	JD
