# Led-walks in North Lincolnshire – Spring 2024

Walking North Lincolnshire host a number of FREE led-walks across North Lincolnshire.

Our walks are open to everybody. There is no need to book prior to your walk. Simply turn up on the day and find one of the walk leaders (they will be wearing a high-visibility vest).

Here are the details of all of our led-walks taking place between March-May 2024.

## Things to remember:

- Please wear comfortable shoes with grip and be aware that some walks may be muddy in places. It is also advisable to bring a drink with you, particularly in warmer weather.
- Please consider residents and other road users when parking and allow adequate room for farming vehicles. Please do not park on verges, block driveways and always consider the Highway Code when parking.
- Assistance dogs are welcome on walks.
- In severe weather conditions, walks may be cancelled. Please call 07717 586380 before 9.30am on the day of the walk if you are in any doubt that a walk will be taking place.

Please consult your GP prior to attending your first walk if you have any concerns about your ability to take part.
