



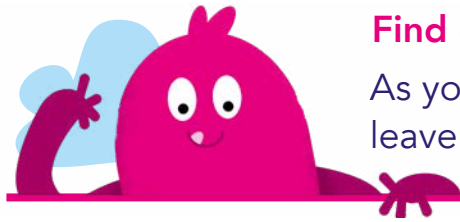
BUSY DAY - ASTRONAUT
