

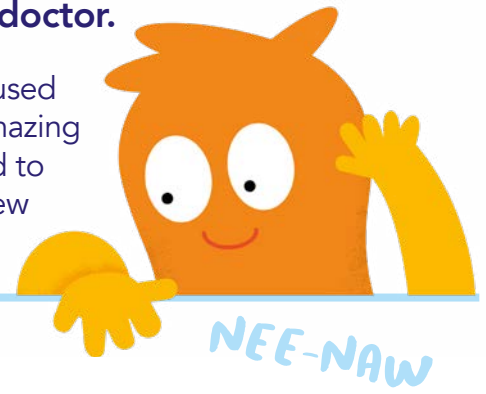


WHEN I GROW UP - DOCTOR
