

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**PUBLIC PATH AND DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION (PUBLIC FOOTPATH  
279, CADNEY CUM HOWSHAM) ORDER 2023(1)**

On 1 May 2024 North Lincolnshire Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath in Cadney cum Howsham running from a point at grid reference TA02630314 east to Poolthorne Farm thence first south then south east via TA03270295 to a point on the north side of North Kelsey Beck at TA03950278 to a line running from a point at TA02630314 generally south then east to and then via first the north side of Cadney Land Drain then the north side of North Kelsey Beck to a point at TA03950278 as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Church Square House, Church Square, Scunthorpe from 9am to 4.30pm on weekdays other than public holidays. The order comes into force as from 8 May 2024, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 30 May 2024, make an application to the High Court.
